

RACER CHECK-IN

Location: Furnace Creek Inn, Gold Rush Room, Sunday, July 23, 2018, 100-400pm

All racers and all designated Crew Chiefs must attend Racer Check-In, while all crew members are encouraged to attend. (Badwater Gear Retail is held at the same.) Additionally, all racers and their designated Crew Chiefs ONLY must attend the Pre-Race Meeting. Those racers and/or their Crew Chiefs who do not complete the scheduled check-in and attend the Pre-Race Meeting will not be allowed to participate in the race. Attendance is mandatory: no exceptions will be made.

YOU MUST BRING:

Proof of Payment of Death Valley National Park Entrance Fee

Note: If you have an National Park Annual Pass or Life Pass, you must still go to the Furnace Creek Visitors Center and obtain a window sticker, and bring that to Racer Check-In.

Gear We Will Check

- 2 Standard Nighttime Running Vests (for runner and pacer to wear at night)
- 8 Blinking Lights (for runner, pacer, and crew to wear at night)
- 8 Biffy Bags (or similar; NOT ziplock bags, NOT dog poop bags)
- 4 OSHA Class 3 high-visibility jackets or Badwater ZZYXXZ Class 3 Shirts

Note: If you have pre-ordered the Badwater ZZYXXZ Class 3 Shirts from us, please get them from us before checking in for the race. If you need to buy any of these shirts, come to Racer Check-In early (by 1230pm) and come inside to purchase them at 100pm, as they are only available in limited numbers!

Each racer must be accompanied by a support crew comprised of no more than one four-wheeled motor vehicle and at least two and no more than four crew members - at least two of whom are legally licensed to drive and at least one of whom can speak English - at all times. Race entrants may have no more than one support vehicle and no more than four crew members in total on the race course. "Unofficial" or extra crew members and "family cheering squads" may only be present in Lone Pine and at the finish line; they may not drive on the race course except between Lone Pine and the finish line and such drive must be made without stopping en route
